Thus, a play environment is created precluding feelings of isolation and literally changing the lives of these special children by allowing them to enjoy playground experiences just like the other kids.

The most enjoyable part of this playground is a water-park feature called the Splash Pad. The Splash Pad consists of several different pieces of playground equipment all utilizing water; so, kids can enjoy some much needed fun in the sun! The Splash Pad includes equipment like the Aqua Arch, Water Cycle and the Spin N' Spray Elephant.

The playground will be constructed in Hartselle at 406 Nance Ford Road, adjacent to the Sparkman Civic Center in the Sparkman Park complex. The location is centrally positioned and easily accessible by the entire Morgan County community.
