## **ELVIS CONCERT FOR SNAP OF MORGAN COUNTY**

**HARTSELLE, Al** – SNAP of Morgan County will be hosting an Elvis Tribute Concert at the Hartselle Civic Center on Saturday, September 29<sup>th</sup>. Renowned Elvis tribute artist, Michael Dean, will perform several popular Elvis songs along with Memphis and J.D. Moss during the concert. Tickets are \$10, and tickets purchased in advance will guarantee floor seating. Doors open at 6:30 p.m., and the show begins at 7:30 p.m.

Tickets are available in Hartselle at the Hartselle Area Chamber of Commerce, Moss Audio, and in Decatur at Root All-State Insurance (6<sup>th</sup> Ave. South). The talent and facility are being donated, allowing SNAP of Morgan County to receive 100% of the proceeds from the concert. All donations will be used to help fund the building of a handicap-accessible playground in Morgan County.

It is estimated that there are more than 1,700 physically challenged children in Morgan County alone who don't have a place to play. The Morgan County SNAP (Special Needs Accessible Playground) project is planning to change that by creating the premier "boundless" playground in the State of Alabama.

The playground will be strategically located in Morgan County on the grounds of the Hartselle Civic Center, home to a host of indoor/outdoor activities for children and adults alike. The unique design, accommodations and central location will make the SNAP playground a "destination attraction", encouraging all children to come play, whether they have special needs or not. Positive interaction between special needs children and those who are not physically challenged helps minimize the outlook special needs children often have of being different.

Individual and commercial business donations are vital to the funding of this much-needed community project. Every donation helps SNAP get closer to their goal of making a difference in the community.
