HARTSELLE, Al – SNAP of Morgan County held a "Lunch 'n Learn" for the area churches at Quail Creek Resort on Wednesday, September 5. The event allowed SNAP's project manager, Bob Francis, to present SNAP's vision to all area church members in attendance.

The meeting was well-attended, and everyone stayed for the question and answer session following the luncheon. During this session, church members learned specific ways in which the ministerial association and the area churches could partner with SNAP of Morgan County in this worthwhile project.

Music during the event was provided by the Glory Road Quartet, and Wal-Mart contributed the food for lunch. All proceeds from the luncheon were graciously donated to SNAP by the Quail Creek Resort.

The playground will be strategically located in Morgan County on the grounds of the Hartselle Civic Center, home to a host of indoor/outdoor activities for children and adults alike. The unique design, accommodations and central location will make the SNAP playground a "destination attraction", encouraging all children to come play, whether they have special needs or not. Positive interaction between special needs children and those who are not physically challenged helps minimize the outlook special needs children often have of being different.
